

HEALTH LAW CERTIFICATE APPLICATION

The School of Law Office of Student Affairs, 324 North High Street, Columbus, OH 43210-1332, the student must:

- Complete this HLCP application including page 2, with dated signatures.
- Obtain admission approval from Assistant Dean of Student Affairs by submitting to Law Student Affairs in the Dean's Office.

An essential aspect of earning a Certificate is the close working relationship between the student and the faculty advisor as part of an enhanced learning experience justifying awarding a Certificate. Students are encouraged to submit applications to enter certificate programs as early as the second year of attendance. The earlier a student begins working with a faculty advisor, the better.

The recommended timeframe to apply for the Health Law Certificate is the second year for full-time students and the third year for part-time students. If a student misses this recommended timeframe, they can still work with the Office of Student
